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Making Classrooms Connected



Our mental health clinician comes on-site to observe the classroom and partner closely with the teaching team to strengthen connection, communication, and relationships within the group. This service focuses on supporting individual children for whom the school aims to enhance emotional safety and relational attunement—while also elevating the overall relational climate for all current and future students.

Includes: A meeting with the clinician and teaching team, an in-class observation, a written report with concrete recommendations, and a follow-up meeting to review strategies, discuss implementation, and reflect on teacher-child interactions. Cost: \$850



Classroom Screeners



We offer screenings for children age 3–5 in the preschool setting. Our pediatric occupational therapist, pediatric speech-language pathologist, and mental health clinician will observe small groups of children to screen for:

The screening will be conducted through a combination of small group, individual tasks, plus classroom observation. The goal is to identify children who may benefit from a comprehensive assessment and early intervention services. Parents will receive a letter indicating whether or not further assessment is recommended for their child. Teachers will receive a summary of general classroom trends that can help guide lesson and curriculum planning.
